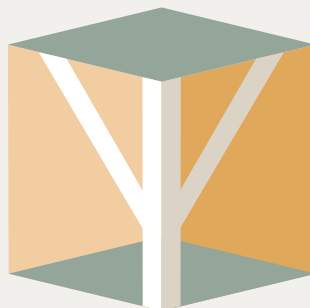

RESTORING THE FOUNDATION FOR FUTURE GENERATIONS

In 1890, four preachers knelt together in the woods outside Jackson, Georgia, and asked God to begin a holiness camp meeting on that land. God answered their prayers, and Indian Springs Holiness Camp Meeting was formed. The foundation for Indian Springs was laid by the prayers, the love, and the sacrifice of four Methodist ministers.

As the camp meeting became established, many others contributed through prayer and financial support, building tabernacles and cottages, creating a sacred space for people to come and hear the message of scriptural holiness.

More than 130 years later, Indian Springs still stands and is growing, continuing to proclaim the message of holiness to new generations. Now, it is time to build on the foundation that those who have gone before us have laid. Our campground facility needs restoration and expansion. The foundations of our Main Tabernacle need immediate reinforcement and repair to protect it from erosion and water damage.

The Board of Trustees of Indian Springs has met and asked God for a plan to fortify and strengthen the foundation of Indian Springs and enable growth for future generations. In the pages that follow, you will find the plan that God has given for restoring the current campground facility and for expanding with new housing and new property.

Our prayer for this new beginning for Indian Springs comes from a promise in the Old Testament:

“You shall raise up the foundations of many generations; you shall be called the repairer of the breach and the restorer of the streets to dwell in.”

Isaiah 58:12

May we be the people who repair the ancient walls and raise up the foundations so that the next generations might have a place to hear the message of full salvation.

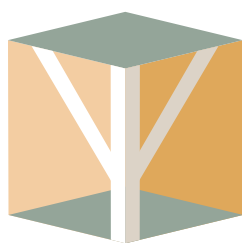

PROJECT DETAILS

The continuation of Indian Springs Holiness Camp Meeting has only been possible through the support of families and individuals dedicated to its message of heart holiness. Even so, today, we recognize several vital repairs and renovations necessary to ensure the preservation of our historic structures and buildings. In addition, we wish to expand our facilities in order to welcome more people to our campground while broadening our spiritual influence on our families, churches, and communities.

To pass the spiritual legacy and rich history of Indian Springs Holiness Camp Meeting to our children, grandchildren, and great-grandchildren, we must continue to offer a place for them to gather, share fellowship, and hear the invitation of full salvation. Join us in honoring all who have been a part of our camp meeting and those yet to come by laying a solid foundation for the future.



CHILDREN & YOUTH FACILITIES

Indian Springs has developed excellent ministries for our children and youth. They are given an opportunity to know Christ personally through worship, fellowship, and play. Children and youth are our hope for the future growth at Indian Springs. Therefore, constructing age-appropriate amenities is one of our utmost priorities.

OUR SOLUTION:

To promote positive camp meeting experiences, we propose two independent builds specifically designed for children and teens to use: a new camp playground and the addition of two youth restroom facilities.



PLAYGROUND: \$100,000

We will be working closely with GameTime, a nationally renowned developer and manufacturer of recreational equipment for children, to create an innovative playground for Indian Springs children. Features of our play area will include safe and easily-maintained equipment, resilient rubber flooring, and covered benches for comfortable guidance.

YOUTH RESTROOM FACILITIES: \$50,000

Currently, the only restrooms available on the youth compound are located within the youth dormitories and unavailable to visiting guests. We wish to build two restrooms and a covered breezeway, including a water fountain, and seating.





RV PARK UPGRADE: \$100,000

Our Recreational Vehicle Park is currently at capacity, preventing more families from attending camp meeting in their vehicles or trailers. Increasing our capacity and enhancing our amenities is an economical way to allow more families to attend camp meeting.

OUR SOLUTION:

With your help, we hope to proceed with the following improvements and additions to our RV park:

- Provide additional RV pads and necessary infrastructure.
- Upgrade the electrical panel grid so it can adequately accommodate the expansion.



RV PARK BATHHOUSE: \$70,000

In addition to expanding our space, we hope to replace our RV bathhouse for comfort, privacy, and efficiency. Doing so will enhance the experience of our current and future RV Park attendees.

OUR SOLUTION:

By contributing to this project, you can help us meet the following objectives:

- Build our new, separate bathhouse, approximately 500 square feet large.
- Implement individual restrooms, family restrooms with showers, and a laundry area into this new space.

CAFETERIA RENOVATIONS: \$80,000

In addition to repairs needed to preserve our Main Tabernacle, we also believe several renovations are necessary for the efficiency and longevity of our cafeteria.

OUR SOLUTION:

By replacing the roof and covered walkway with quality metal materials, and adding trusses to enhance water

run-off, we can protect our ventilation and mechanical systems from moisture and preserve the integrity of the cafeteria's foundation and structure.

These essential repairs and replacements will allow Indian Springs Holiness Camp Meeting to offer quality and highly functional spaces for all attendees and guests.

MAIN TABERNACLE REPAIRS: \$75,000

Our Main Tabernacle is a place where generations of camp meeting attendees have gathered to hear the word of God and worship Him with praise for more than 130 years. Today, our Tabernacle requires vital repair, largely due to excess water flow that has caused foundational and structural issues. We implore our friends of Indian Springs to help us restore this historic center of worship so that it may stand for years to come.

OUR SOLUTION:

In order to repair our Tabernacle, we propose the installation of a

French drainage system which will divert or stop the excessive water flow. We must also replace damaged interior wooden columns, replace or level the uneven flooring, and restore critical foundational points that support the roof structure.

These essential repairs will protect the Tabernacle foundations, allowing preaching and teaching at Indian Springs to continue for years to come.





PLUMBING & SEWER: \$80,000

The history of our camp meeting is a testament to our community's dedication. Yet, time has also placed many strains on our structures and facilities. Now, we recognize a need for considerable plumbing renovations.

Due to the age of our campground, our plumbing materials are inconsistent and outdated. Limited materials and budget restrictions have led to a variety of pipes that are difficult and costly to repair or replace. Years of development have resulted in several plumbing line locations that are inaccessible or even unknown.

OUR SOLUTION:

Consulting the leadership of the Georgia Rural Water Association, we propose developing a plan for the maintenance and future growth of our grounds and its infrastructure. Determining all present complications and needs as well as assessing appropriate repairs and replacements will allow us to facilitate these renovations as successfully and cost-effectively as possible.



RETAINING WALLS & BACKFILL: \$70,000

Erosion has affected the efficiency of our roads, making them unsafe for normal vehicular traffic. Building adjacent retaining walls, backfilling them with dirt, and adding culverts are wise precautions against future problems.

OUR SOLUTION:

Installing wooden retaining walls and filling necessary areas with new soil will prevent further erosion. Doing so will also allow vehicles safe access around various recreational areas on our campground.



AFFORDABLE COTTAGE FUND: \$200,000

Our community is growing, and due to the limited exchange of existing cottages, we must expand to meet the increasing demand for cottage ownership on our campground.

OUR SOLUTION:

Our proposed Affordable Cottage Fund will assist families desiring to purchase or build cottages on the campground through a renewable loan fund.

Together, we can grow our community and help more families develop a spiritual legacy that will last a lifetime here at Indian Springs Holiness Camp Meeting.

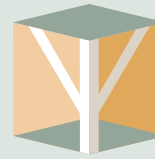
NEW PROPERTY: \$175,000 A FOUNDATION TO THE FUTURE
