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Restoring THE FOUNDATION For Future Generations

130 years after four Methodist preachers established these grounds as a sacred place for followers of Christ, Indian Springs still stands and is growing, continuing to proclaim the message of holiness to new generations. Now, it is time to build on the foundation that those who have gone before us have laid.

"You shall raise up the foundations of many generations; you shall be called the repairer of the breach and the restorer of the streets to dwell in."

Isaiah 58:12

May we be the people who repair the ancient walls and raise up the foundations so that the next generations might have a place to hear the message of full salvation...

PLAYGROUND: \$100,000

We plan to create an innovative playground including safe and easily-maintained equipment, resilient rubber flooring, and covered benches for comfortable guidance.

NEW YOUTH RESTROOMS: \$50,000

To improve ease and accessibility, we wish to build two restrooms and a covered breezeway, including a water fountain, and seating on our youth compound.

RV PARK UPGRADE: \$100,000

In order adequately accommodate more families at Indians Springs, we plan to implement additional RV pads and necessary infrastructure and upgrade our current electrical panel grid.

RV PARK BATHHOUSE: \$70,000

Our new build (approximately 500 square feet large) will feature a separate RV Bathhouse with individual restrooms, family restrooms with showers, and a laundry area improving comfort, privacy, and efficiency.

CAFETERIA RENOVATIONS: \$80,000

By replacing the roof and covered walkway of our Cafeteria, and adding trusses to enhance water run-off, we can protect our ventilation and mechanical systems from moisture, preserving the integrity of the cafeteria's foundation and structure.

MAIN TABERNACLE REPAIRS: \$75,000

To ensure the longevity of our beloved Main Tabernacle, we propose a plan to install a French drainage system that will divert or stop the excessive water flow, replace damaged interior wooden columns and uneven flooring, and restore critical foundational points that support the roof structure.

PLUMBING & SEWER: \$80,000

To improve our current plumbing materials and lines, we propose a plan to maintain and restore our grounds and its infrastructure while determining all present complications and needs and assessing appropriate repairs and replacements.

RETAINING WALLS & BACKFILL: \$70,000

Installing wooden retaining walls and filling necessary areas with new soil will prevent continued erosion and allow vehicles safe access around various recreational areas.

AFFORDABLE COTTAGE FUND: \$200,000

To accommodate our growing community and the limited exchange of existing cottages, we propose the Affordable Cottage Fund which will assist families desiring to purchase or build cottages on the campground through a renewable loan fund.

NEW PROPERTY: \$175,000

Breaking ground for new cottages, worship centers, and facilities, developing walking trails, creating additional parking areas, and expanding plumbing are just a few of the many ways we look forward to utilizing our newly purchased 28 acres of land.
